- Title of the workshop
- Names of the workshop organizers, affiliation, email
- A description of the topics of the workshop (approx. 250 words)
- Type of the workshop (full papers or abstracts)
- A list of reviewers and program committee members and a brief description of the review process

Submission Format:

Papers should be submitted in LNCS (Lecture Notes in Computer Science) format (style files are available at LNCS Authors Instructions) as PostScript or PDF files, and may not exceed 12 pages for regular paper, industry papers up to 6 pages.
